## COUNCILMAN DOMINGUEZ

Councilman Dominguez discussed which renters will be able to take advantage of the AUD program. Since the target group will have incomes 120% to 200% of the area median he thinks it a serious failing that moderate income renters will not be able to benefit. He also thinks the city should be encouraging home ownership. He discussed various ways the public might effect change in the AUD program."
